My name is James Barnhill a retired employee of BMHC listed as an unsecured creditor. As stated in the Bankruptcy, BMHC purchased an insurance policy for the purpose of securing the retires Pension. The insurance retirement policy was for the retired employees and not for BMHC to use as collateral for fiancing the corporation. We do not believe that Banks and others should be able to confiscate these retirement funds to secure a part of their losses, leaving us the retired employees with little or no retirement funds.

We wonder if any officers of BMHC that has recently retired took the lump sum option knowingly removing assets they knew or might be in danger of this Bankruptcy. If this is the case
