Robert A. Garcia ("Mr. Garcia" or "Applicant"), by Committee counsel and pursuant to paragraph 3 of this Court's Professional Fee Order Establishing Procedures For Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses For Professionals dated July 14, 2009 (the "Professional Fee Order") (D.E. 201), hereby files this First and Final Application for Reimbursement of Expenses Incurred as Member and Chairperson of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors ("Committee") for the Period of June 16, 2009 through October 31, 2009 (the "Application"). In support of the Application, Mr. Garcia respectfully represents as follows:

#### **INTRODUCTION**

1. By this Application, Mr. Garcia seeks reimbursement of reasonable expenses incurred during his tenure as Committee Member and Chairperson during the period of June 16, 2009 through October 31, 2009 (the "Expense Period"). The expenses consist of 100% of the out-of-pocket costs that Mr. Garcia incurred in connection with his duties as Member and Chairperson of the Committee during the Expense Period in the amount of \$6,719.75.

#### FACTUAL BACKGROUND

- 2. On June 16, 2009, each of the Debtors filed voluntary petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "Court"). The Debtors remain in possession of their assets as debtors-in-possession pursuant to Section 1107 and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code.
- On June 26, 2009, the Office of the United States Trustee appointed the
   Committee. See Docket No. 108. The United States Trustee appointed Mr. Garcia as one of the three members of the Committee.

- 2. Also on June 26, 2009, the Committee elected to retain Arent Fox as counsel, subject to approval by this Court. On July 10, 2009, the Court approved the retention of Arent Fox as counsel to the Committee *nunc pro tunc* to June 26, 2009. See Docket No. 414.
- 3. Shortly following Arent Fox's election as counsel for the Committee, the Committee selected Mr. Garcia as its Chairperson. Mr. Garcia, a resident of Sacramento, California, and a former employee of the Debtors, has been an active participant in these cases. Mr. Garcia has provided invaluable insight into the Debtors' business and history by virtue of his involvement in the Debtors' operations prior to Mr. Garcia's retirement.
- 4. On October 30, 3009, the Court entered its Order Appointing Fee Auditor and Directing Related Procedures Concerning the Payment of Compensation and Consideration of Fee Applications (the "Fee Auditor Order") (D.E. 808). Pursuant to the Fee Auditor Order, the Court appointed Direct Fee Review, LLC ("Direct Fee Review") as the Fee Auditor in the above-referenced bankruptcy cases.

#### **DESCRIPTION OF EXPENSES COVERED HEREIN**

5. The Fee Procedures Order provides that Committee Members shall be permitted to submit statements of expenses and supporting vouchers to Committee's counsel for collection and submission for reimbursement in accordance with the Compensation Procedures (as defined by the Fee Procedures Order). See Fee Procedures Order at p.4, paragraph 3. Mr. Garcia's Expenses include reasonable expenses incurred related to his travel from California to Delaware for key events such as the Committee formation meeting and two hearings on approval of the Disclosure Statement. Mr. Garcia incurred additional miscellaneous expenses related to his tenure as Committee Member and Chairperson, namely consulting fees for his consultation as

Chairperson with his personal accountant who reviewed and explained various financial analyses to Mr. Garcia. The following narratives describe Mr. Garcia's expenses:

- 1. <u>Formation Meeting Expenses</u>. On June 25, 2009, Mr. Garcia traveled to Wilmington to attend the Committee formation meeting that was to be held on June 26, 2009. In connection with his travels, Mr. Garcia incurred \$886.40 in expenses for roundtrip airfare, \$372.12 in expenses for lodging and \$61.00 for three meals: \$17.05 for breakfast on June 26, 2009; \$28.00 for dinner on June 26, 2009; and \$15.95 for breakfast on June 27, 2009. Each of these meal expenses complies with or substantially complies with Direct Fee Review's \$15/\$25/\$50 limits on reasonableness of charges for breakfast, lunch and dinner, respectively. Mr. Garcia also incurred \$91.00 in expenses for travel to and from the hotel and the airport via Delaware Express, an airport shuttle service. True and correct copies of Mr. Garcia's Expenses and supporting documents are attached hereto as "Exhibit 'A'".
- 2. Expenses Related to Hearings on Approval of Disclosure Statement. The hearing on approval of the Disclosure Statement was originally scheduled for July 16, 2009. Mr. Garcia traveled to Wilmington to attend the hearing on the Disclosure Statement and several other matters that were scheduled for hearing. However, the Debtors adjourned the hearing on approval of the Disclosure Statement to a later date. In connection with his travels, Mr. Garcia incurred \$1,096.41 in expenses for roundtrip airfare related to the July 16, 2009 hearing. See Exhibit 'A'. Mr. Garcia also incurred additional expenses in connection with the October 7, 2009 final hearing on approval of the Disclosure Statement. In connection with his travels, Mr. Garcia incurred \$1,408.80 in expenses for roundtrip airfare, \$343.44 in expenses for lodging and \$18.00 for dinner on October 6, 2009. Mr. Garcia also incurred \$56.98 for travel to and from the

hotel and the airport via taxicab. True and correct copies of Mr. Garcia's Expenses and supporting documents are attached hereto as "Exhibit 'B'".

3. Consulting Services, Photocopies & Miscellaneous Expenses. Mr. Garcia also incurred miscellaneous expenses related to consulting, photocopying and other expenses. Specifically, Mr. Garcia incurred \$2,362.50 in expenses related to services rendered by Raymond J. Sala d/b/a ATI Financial Services ("ATI") in connection with Mr. Garcia's responsibilities and duties as Chairman of the Committee. ATI assisted Mr. Garcia in understanding provisions of the Disclosure Statement, Plan and other financial documents. ATI also assisted Mr. Garcia in formulating questions and issues to raise with the Committee professionals. Mr. Garcia also incurred \$23.10 in expenses related to photocopying of documents in preparation for the hearing on approval of the Disclosure Statement. Specifically, Mr. Garcia purchased 236 copies for \$23.10, which is within the \$.10 per copy limitation set forth in the Local Rules and Direct Fee Review's guidelines. See Exhibit 'A".

# APPLICANT'S EXPENSES ARE ACTUAL, NECESSARY AND BENEFICIAL TO THE COMMITTEE AND THE DEBTORS' ESTATES

- 4. The expenses described herein are the actual and necessary expenses incurred by Mr. Garcia during the Expense Period in connection with his tenure as Committee Member and Chairperson.
- 5. By this Application, Mr. Garcia requests that the Court approve reimbursement of one-hundred percent (100%) of the expenses incurred by Mr. Garcia during the Expense Period and evidenced by the attached exhibits. All expenses for which Mr. Garcia requests reimbursement were incurred at the direction or instruction of the Committee and for or on behalf of the Committee and in furtherance of Mr. Garcia's duties as a Committee Member and Chairperson in the Debtors' Chapter 11 cases. These expenses are reasonable, necessary and

beneficial to the Committee, the Debtors' estates, creditors and other parties in interest, and in furtherance of the administration of these proceedings.

6. In accordance with the Bankruptcy Rules, Local Rules for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, and other applicable law, Mr. Garcia respectfully submits that the amount requested as reimbursement of necessary expenses is fair and reasonable.

WHEREFORE, Robert A. Garcia respectfully requests that the Court approve and allow reimbursement of actual and necessary costs and expenses in the amount of \$6,719.75 for the Expense Period and grant such other and further relief as may be just and proper.

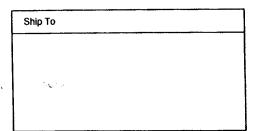
