**CERTIFICATION OF COUNSEL REGARDING REORGANIZED DEBTORS’
TWENTY-FIRST OMNIBUS (NON-SUBSTANTIVE) OBJECTION TO CLAIMS
PURSUANT TO SECTION 502(b) OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE,
BANKRUPTCY RULES 3003 AND 3007 AND LOCAL RULE 3007-1**

On July 23, 2010, Building Materials Holding Corporation and its affiliates, as reorganized debtors (collectively, the “Reorganized Debtors”), filed their Twenty-First Omnibus (Non-Substantive) Objection to Claims Pursuant to Section 502(b) of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rules 3003 and 3007 and Local Rule 3007-1 [Docket No. 1639] (the “Claims Objection”). Thereafter, the following parties contacted the Debtors with an informal response regarding the Claims Objection (collectively, the “Responses”): Bryce D. Panzer on account of Price Lakeshore, LLC (“Price Lakeshore”); and Four Embarcadero Center Venture (collectively, the “Respondents,” and together with Price Lakeshore and the Reorganized Debtors, the “Parties”). Prior to the response deadline, no other comments or responses were received by the Reorganized Debtors to the Claims Objection.



Subsequent to the Reorganized Debtors' receipt of the Responses, they have worked with the Respondents in an effort to resolve the Responses and have done so through certain modifications to the proposed form of order filed with the Claims Objection (the "Proposed Order") and Exhibits A, B, C and D attached thereto (collectively, the "Exhibits"). In light of this, attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is a revised Proposed Order (the "Revised Proposed Order").² The Reorganized Debtors submit that the Revised Proposed Order is appropriate and consistent with the Claims Objection and the Parties' discussions, and that entry of the order is in the best interests of the Reorganized Debtors, their estates and creditors. The Respondents have consented to the entry of the Revised Proposed Order.

Accordingly, the Reorganized Debtors respectfully request the Court to enter the Revised Proposed Order, attached hereto as Exhibit 1, at its earliest convenience without further notice or a hearing.

**ORDER SUSTAINING REORGANIZED DEBTORS' TWENTY-FIRST
OMNIBUS (NON-SUBSTANTIVE) OBJECTION TO CLAIMS
PURSUANT TO SECTION 502(b) OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE,
BANKRUPTCY RULES 3003 AND 3007 AND LOCAL RULE 3007-1**

Upon consideration of the twenty-first omnibus (non-substantive) objection (the “Objection”)² of the above-captioned reorganized debtors (collectively, the “Reorganized Debtors”) for the entry of an order, pursuant to section 502(b) of title 11 of the United States Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101 et seq. (the “Bankruptcy Code”), Rules 3003 and 3007 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the “Bankruptcy Rules”) and Rule 3007-1 of the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Practice and Procedure for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the “Local Rules”), reassigning or disallowing and expunging in full each of the Disputed Claims identified on Exhibits A, B, C and D attached hereto; and it appearing that due and sufficient notice of the Objection has been given under the circumstances; and after due

deliberation and upon the Court's determination that the relief requested in the Objection is in the best interests of the Reorganized Debtors, their estates and creditors and other parties in interest; and sufficient cause appearing for the relief requested in the Objection, it is hereby:

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:

1. The Objection is sustained to the extent provided for herein and on Exhibits A, B, C and D attached hereto.
2. Pursuant to section 502(b) of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rules 3003 and 3007 and Local Rule 3007-1, the Disputed Claims identified on the attached Exhibit A are hereby reassigned to the New Case Numbers as indicated on Exhibit A.
3. Pursuant to section 502(b) of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rules 3003 and 3007 and Local Rule 3007-1, the Disputed Claims identified on Exhibits B, C and D attached hereto are hereby disallowed and expunged in their entirety.
4. Pursuant to section 502(b) of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rules 3003 and 3007 and Local Rule 3007-1, Claims Numbers 686 and 687 (together, the "Price Lakeshore Claims") filed by Bryce D. Panzer on account of Price Lakeshore, LLC ("Price Lakeshore") shall each be Allowed General Unsecured Claims against BMC West Corporation under the Plan, and the Price Lakeshore Claims shall supersede, in its entirety, the \$89,489.19 claim for Price Lakeshore scheduled by the Debtors against SelectBuild Construction, Inc. in its Schedules of Assets and Liabilities filed in the Chapter 11 Cases.
5. Pursuant to section 502(b) of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rules 3003 and 3007 and Local Rule 3007-1, Claim Number 2888 (the "Four Embarcadero Center Claim") filed by Four Embarcadero Center Venture shall be an Allowed General Unsecured Claim under the Plan, and the Four Embarcadero Center Claim shall supersede, in their entirety,

the \$87.50 claim and the \$115,124.83 claim for Boston Properties scheduled by the Debtors against BMC West Corporation in its Schedules of Assets and Liabilities filed in the Chapter 11 Cases.

6. The Reorganized Debtors (and any successors or successors in interest) reserve any and all rights to amend, modify or supplement this Objection, and to file additional objections to any and all claims filed in these chapter 11 cases, including, without limitation, any and all claims that are the subject of the Objection.

7. The Reorganized Debtors (and any successors or successors in interest) reserve any and all rights to object to any and all of the Disputed Claims and the Surviving Claims on any and all grounds in any and all additional objections to claims filed in these chapter 11 cases.

8. This Court shall retain jurisdiction over any and all affected parties with respect to any and all matters, claims or rights arising from or related to the implementation or interpretation of this Order.
