I submit this Supplemental Declaration, pursuant to sections 327(a) and 329 of title 11 of the United States Code, Rules 2014 and 2016(b) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, and Rule 2014-1 of the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Practice and Procedure for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, in support of the Debtors' Application Pursuant to Sections 327(a) and 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code for an Order Authorizing the Debtors to Retain and Employ PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP as Tax
