Please accept my claim as a personal shareholder with substantial investment value in BMHC in my individual retirement account. My claim was submitted in good faith and I strongly believe that my claim should not be rejected for being only 14 days late when I've been a personal shareholder for over 15 years. Please take into consideration that shareholders may not have been given adequate notice/time to respond and no reminders were received.

As a personal BMC West investor in my Individual Retirement Account (Charles Schwab IRA account) since 1993, the bankruptcy court documents were received at my home during our busy summer vacation time and no second reminder received, and I still responded in good faith within a reasonable time.

Considering the time of year, I believe the response time provided was not adequate and there was not sufficient notices or reminders provided. Businesses may have dedicated staff to respond to notices in a timely manner but as a single mother of two teenage sons, we were out of town during some of the response period and occupied with summer activities/travels and preparing for my son's return to high school so the deadline was inadvertently missed.

It would be unfair and unjust that after being a shareholder of BMC West and Building Materials Holding Corp for over 15 years that my holdings and share should be expunged or disallowed for being only 14 days late.

All efforts to comply to court obligations were responded to in good faith, and your consideration and acceptance of my claim submittal is appreciated.

- (e) the address(es) to which the Debtors must return any reply to the Response, if different from that presented in the Disputed Claim; and
- (f) the name, address and telephone number of the person (which may be the claimant or its legal representative) possessing ultimate authority to reconcile, settle or otherwise resolve the Disputed Claim or Response on behalf of the responding party.


